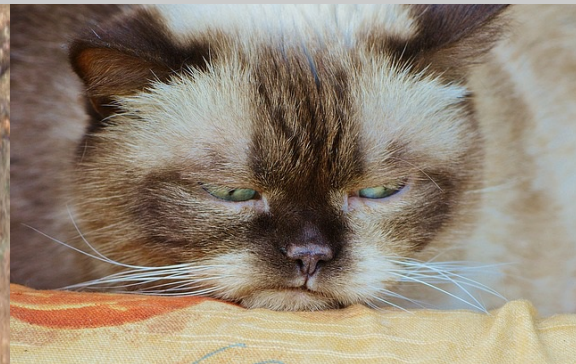
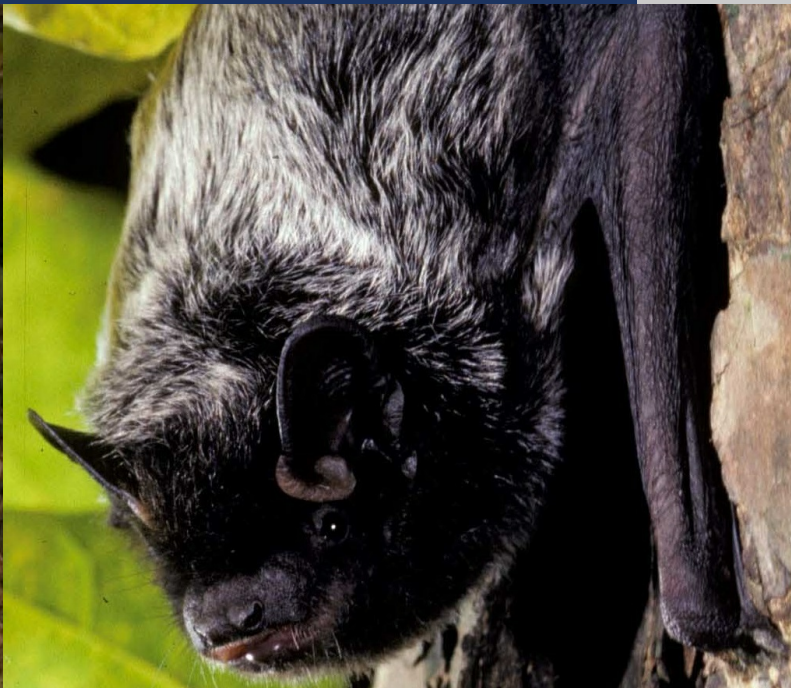


Rabies Management Training 2018

What's my role in managing rabies exposures?

The scope of this training will educate public health professionals and their rabies response partners regarding the investigation and management of potential rabies exposures. These modules will give attendees the knowledge and resources necessary to successfully manage potential rabies exposures. Attendees will participate in rabies scenario exercises as a group.

The training will start at 9 am on the selected day and will conclude at 4 pm to allow for same-day travel. Attendees will be given an hour for lunch (lunch is on your own). There is no charge to attend the training. However, all travel costs are the responsibility of the attendee.
